

Executive summary – Germany

- Most of Germany wants green energy.
 - **84%** believe it is important to create a world fully powered by renewable energy, regardless of age, education level or political ideology.
- Support for renewable energy is especially rooted in:
 - **National pride about technology leadership. 75%** say they will be proud if Germany invests time and money to become a global leader in green energy.
 - **Concern about climate change. 71%** believe climate change is a global challenge, making it the second-most pressing global challenge in Germany.
 - **Economic benefits. 75%** say building and producing more green energy will boost economic growth.
 - **Environmental benefits. 74%** believe that Germany should lead the green energy transition to increase the energy independence and get an positive environmental impact.
- People in Germany want their country to increase usage of a variety of renewable energy types including **solar, offshore wind and tidal power.**
