Executive summary – Netherlands

- Most of the Netherlands wants green energy.
 - 81% believe it is important to create a world fully powered by renewable energy, regardless of age, education level or political ideology.
- Support for renewable energy is especially rooted in:
 - National pride about technology leadership. 69% say they will be proud if the Netherlands invests time and money to become a global leader in green energy.
 - Concern about climate change. 71% believe climate change is a global challenge, making it the second-most pressing global challenge in the Netherlands.
 - Economic benefits. 74% say building and producing more green energy will boost economic growth.
 - A public will to stop the use of coal. 84% say they want the Netherlands to phase out the use coal.
- People in the Netherlands want their country to increase usage of a variety of renewable energy types including solar and offshore wind.
