

# Owenreagh/Craignagapple Wind Farm


We would like to update you on the project since our first leaflet drop at the start of September. In this update flyer you will find a map showing the site location, some updates to the project timeline including the first community consultation event, and a reminder of how to contact us with any questions you may have about the project.

#### Site Location

The map below shows the location of the proposed wind farm development. The existing turbines at Owenreagh I wind farm will be removed and taller, more efficient turbines are proposed for this site. The proposed locations of these turbines are still being assessed. They will be shared with the local community in the second leaflet which is due to be circulated in November. Photomontages, showing how the wind turbines will look from some key locations, will be presented at the first community consultation events.



The map on the next page shows the location of the site relative to local towns and settlements.



## **Project Program Updates**

In the first leaflet we stated that we expected the first community consultation events to be held in September. In order to present more detailed information about the wind farm development to the community, we are postponing the events until the week commencing 22nd November 2021. We will provide the local community with information on how they can get involved via newspaper notices, posters in local community venues and invitations delivered to all houses within 3km of the development. We will also include information on our project website **www. craignagaplewindfarm.com**. The second community consultation events are now provisionally scheduled to take place in January/February 2022.

We originally expected the planning application to be submitted in Spring 2022, however we now plan to submit the application to the Department for Infrastructure in Summer 2022.
