Scope Description

The existing William Floyd bridge to Smith Point beach Parking lot has a weight limitation that is a challenge to the transport of heavy equipment to support the HDD and onshore export cable duct bank works. Therefore a barge transport solution is selected as an alternative means of transportation.

We are looking for a company that can construct/Install the floating pier, establish an earthen transition pad on the shoreline. Operate the barge including tug/pushboats transports to and from Shirley Park Marina. Alternative solutions can be proposed.

Have means and capabilities to prevent/mitigate the structure to be impacted from potential ice on the Intra Coastal Waterways during the winter period.

The duration of these deliveries will be from approx. December 2023 to late April 2024 and potentially repeated from November 2024 to April 2025.

Scope Description

Orsted shall award a contract for installation of a bundle of conduits or separate conduits by means of Horizontal Directional Drilling. The HDD installed conduits shall enable the subsequent installation of HV cables which shall transfer the power generated from the wind farm into the electricity grid.

The appointed HDD Contractor will be selected based on their technical capabilities, amongst other criteria. The contractor will need to demonstrate a track record of undertaking complex HDD including large diameter HDPE and long length >800m operations. Preference will be given to the Contractor with proven experience of Landfall HDD where marine operations will be needed to support the drillings.

The works is planned to commence during the Fall and Winter period of 2023. The location of the works is Fire Island, Long Island, NYS.

The appointed Contractor shall be committed to sourcing local labour to support the core HDD and Marine works.
