Scope Description

A Service Operations Vessel (SOV) will be servicing Sunrise windfarm, and the work and services performed by the maritime crews are ship navigation, coordination and logistical support with CTVs, dockside support services of loading materials, resupply of consumables, and crew changes.

Work, Goods and Services:

- Dockside Services (fueling, water supply, forklift services, consumable waste processors, recycle and recovery services, etc.
- Logistics Services (crew housing, hotel, transportation services)
- Resupply Services (groceries, consumables, etc.)
- Service and Repair Services (machinery, electrical, electronic, hydraulic, fitters/welding services, etc.)

Edison Chouest is looking for Maritime Crews (Master, Mate, Engineers, A/B Seaman, Vessel Crane Operators, etc.). 40+ maritime employees, that can perform onboard services; for which the company is currently hiring and getting trained while the SOV is still under construction

This scope will be delivered partly in New York (Port Jefferson) partly in Rhode Island, from mid-late 2024
