



Advance Work Notice – Plumstead Road – Road Closure

Upcoming Works

As part of our work to prepare for construction of the Hornsea 3 cable route, we are required to transport equipment and materials to and from our main compound in Oulton.

Due to the nature of our works, some of these deliveries require larger specialised vehicles called abnormal loads to transport them. To allow the safe passage of these vehicles, we will need to conduct tree pruning on parts of the route. This is so vehicles don't come into contact with overhanging trees that have become overgrown.

To facilitate these works, we will be temporarily closing **Plumstead Road** between the following dates:

Tuesday 8 October to Wednesday 9 October 2024, at all times.

During this time a temporary diversion route will be in place. The diversion route can be found overleaf. Plumstead Road will be closed to through traffic, but local access will be maintained up to where the team is working.

If you are concerned about accessing your property during this time, please contact us using the details at the end of this letter.

What to expect

- You might see us working on site during the day. Our working hours are 7:30 to 17:30, Monday to Friday.
- Some low-level noise from onsite machinery during working hours.

What we will do

- Keep all sites safe and secure, while keeping disruption to a minimum.

Please note that all our works are subject to site and weather conditions and all the dates in this notification are subject to change.
