South Fork Wind Fisheries Monitoring

Trawl survey, South Fork Wind Farm Cable Route

About the Wind Farm

South Fork Wind is a 50-50 joint ventures between Ørsted and Eversource.

South Fork Wind is a planned offshore wind farm located 35 miles east of Montauk Point.

In September 2021, Cornell University Cooperative Extension will be conducting a trawl survey on the F/V Bulldog in the near-shore waters along the southern coast of Long Island. The survey is scheduled to occur between September 11th and September 18th (weather dependent). The trawl survey will occur over approximately 5 days, and the crew intends to sample approximately 40 stations along the route of the South Fork Wind Export Cable, and at a nearby reference site. Tows will be 20 minutes in duration, at a speed of roughly 3 knots, so each tow will cover approximately one nautical mile. See the attached chart for an outline of the areas that will be surveyed.
