SPECIFIC CONSTRUCTION TO START IN YOUR AREA

Dear Neighbor,

Construction of the Revolution Wind project (the Project) has begun in your area, located in the Town of North Kingstown. The Project is being constructed by Eversource & Ørsted and its contractors and subcontractors. Crews are underway with the second phase of onshore construction for the Project. The route is roughly one mile-long and is within the Quonset Business Park. The Project will build a new substation which will interconnect to the existing Davisville substation.

Starting next Monday, March 18th, crews will be mobilizing back to Circuit Drive outside the Blue Beach parking lot. This work zone will require a temporary work zone and full road closure outside the Blue Beach parking lot. If work is delayed or altered, an updated notice will be provided to neighbors regarding the new schedule.

What You Can Expect

- Location of Work:
 - Construction activity will take place on Circuit Drive.
- Traffic Management:
 - Thru-traffic will not be able to travel past the Blue Beach parking lot on Circuit Drive. Please use the most direct route off Roger Williams Way, Circuit Drive or Burlingham Ave, to access your place of business. "Detour" and "Road Closure" signage will be posted along all impacted ways.
 - We coordinated and will continue to coordinate closely with town officials to maintain a safe and effective flow of traffic around Project work areas and to provide emergency access if needed.
- Work Hours:
 - Crews are anticipated to begin the mobilization and road closure on Monday, March 18th. Work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Construction Activities:
 - 1. Crews will be mobilizing equipment and setting up a temporary work zone on Circuit Drive.
 - 2. Trenches will be dug using an excavator and dump-truck.
 - 3. Conduit piping will be delivered and then installed into the trenches as they are dug
 - 4. Once conduit piping has been installed, crews will backfill the trenches and retore the disrupted area. At the end of each workday, steel plates will be used to cover exposed trenches.
 - 5. Equipment will include dump-trucks, excavators, jackhammers, and concrete saws
 - 6. When possible, crews will look to expedite this process and minimize any disruption as much as possible
