SPECIFIC CONSTRUCTION TO START IN YOUR AREA

Dear Neighbor,

Construction of the Revolution Wind project (the Project) has begun in your area, located in the Town of North Kingstown. The Project is being constructed by Eversource & Ørsted and its contractors and subcontractors. The first phase of onshore construction for the Project is underway. The route is roughly one mile-long and is within the Quonset Business Park, The Project will build a new substation which will interconnect to the existing Davisville substation.

Later this week, crews will continue working on the onshore steel casing at 244 Burlingham Avenue, the onshore cable landfall site. If work is delayed, an updated notice will be provided to neighbors regarding the new schedule.

What You Can Expect

- Location of Work:
 - o Construction activity will take place within the enclosed work zone at 244 Burlingham Avenue.
- <u>Traffic Management:</u>
 - o We coordinated and will continue to coordinate closely with town officials to maintain a safe and effective flow of traffic around Project work areas and to provide emergency access if needed.
- Work Hours:
 - This work will take place in two phases, preparing and welding the steel casing will take place early in the week, starting Monday, October 30th. Beginning on Wednesday, November 1st, crews will begin hammering the casting until Tuesday, November 7th. Work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Crews will not be working on Sunday, November 5th.
- Construction Activities:
 - 1. Preparation activities include welding of the steel casing
 - 2. The main work will result in some noise and vibrations as the casing is hammered out of the ground
 - Equipment will include compressors, percussive hammers, steel casings, excavators, and telehandlers
 - 4. The hammering process will take approximately 3-4 hours per day but is subject to change based on ground conditions
 - 5. When possible, crews will look to expedite this process and minimize any disruption as much as possible
