**SPECIFIC CONSTRUCTION** TO START IN YOUR AREA

Dear Neighbor,

Construction of the Revolution Wind project (the Project) has begun in your area, located in the Town of North Kingstown. The Project is being constructed by Revolution Wind and its contractors and subcontractors. Crews have begun the first phase of onshore construction for the Project. The route is roughly one mile-long and is within the Quonset Business Park. The Project will build a new substation which will interconnect to the existing Davisville substation.

Crews will begin working on vessel activity off of Blue Beach for the Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) work and support. If work is delayed, an updated notice will be provided to neighbors regarding the new schedule.

## **What You Can Expect**

- Location of Work:
  - Vessel activity will take place approximately 2000 feet off the shore of Blue Beach located in Quonset.
- Traffic Management:
  - We coordinated and will continue to coordinate closely with town officials to maintain a safe and effective flow of traffic around Project work areas and to provide emergency access if needed.
- Work Hours:
  - o Crews are anticipated to begin offshore vessel activity starting Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. You can expect to see this offshore vessel work continue into Mid-November. Work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Construction Activities:
  - 1. Crews will be mobilizing 8 vessels 2000 feet off of the shore of Blue Beach.
  - 2. The purpose of these vessels will be to conduct survey work, tow the HDPE conduit, dredging, and offering support to other operations.
  - 3. Equipment will include survey vessels, tugboats, barges, and crane barges
  - 4. When possible, crews will look to expedite this process and minimize any disruption as much as possible
