

Pavement Core Samples

Purpose

South Fork Wind is performing pavement borings to collect the data that will inform the detailed design of the onshore cable route.

To acquire these samplings, core samples will be taken of the pavement and asphalt within each lane and shoulder of the Montauk Highway. The cores will be taken from shallow holes, approximately 2 - 4 inches in diameter and with a depth of approximately 12 inches.

Temporary lane closures will be required, but two way traffic will be maintained. Cones, signage and flaggers will be used as traffic management. Business access will be maintained throughout.

The borings will be performed using a drill rig and will be restored once completed.

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Timeline & Location

→ MONTAUK HIGHWAY

5 core samples will be taken within the roadway of the Montauk Highway, west of the intersection of Wainscott Northwest Road.



Timeline: Beginning as early as March 1, lasting approximately two weeks. All work will be conducted Monday - Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00p.m.

No lane closures will occur before 10 a.m. or after 3 p.m.

No work will occur on holidays.
