SUNRISE WIND



Archaeological Survey & Site Evaluation

Purpose

Sunrise Wind will be performing archaeological & biological surveys to inform the detailed design of the onshore cable route.

This work is important to ensure the project's activities do not disturb any important, undiscovered cultural or historical resources.

The surveys will consist of a series of hand-dug holes, roughly two feet wide and four feet deep. No machinery will be used in the completion of this work.

The holes will be backfilled once completed with the same soil and the original sod to leave behind a minimal footprint.

Timeline & Location

→ Town of Brookhaven

All survey activities will occur in the Town of Brookhaven, NY and will be conducted on town, county, and state owned grassy shoulders of the paved roadways and wooded portions of road medians. No work will be done on private property.

Work will take place along portions of the following roads: William Floyd Parkway, Horse Block Rd, & Manor Road.

Timeline: Beginning in early April into May. Work is anticipated to last approximately 5weeks.
