

Geotechnical Surveys & Site Evaluation

Purpose

Sunrise Wind is gathering soil samples to collect the data that will inform the detailed design of the onshore cable route and landfall.

To acquire these samplings, soil borings will be taken along the planned cable route. Each boring will be an approximately 4-6 inch wide hole and up to 40 feet deep. The exact boring locations may be modified to accommodate site conditions and to minimize impacts to the site during sampling.

The borings will be backfilled once completed and our contractor will responsibly dispose of any drill spoils generated from the activities at an approved solid waste facility.

Timeline & Location

→ TOWN AND COUNTY ROADS

Borings will be performed using a truck-mounted drill rig within the Town, County and State owned road right-of-way along the following roads: Union Ave, Long Island Ave, Mastic Blvd, Manor Rd, Horseblock Rd, Victory Ave, William Floyd Pkwy, Expressway South. Additionally, activities will occur at the Smith Point Marina & Smith Point County Park, and within utility-owned or controlled property.

Timeline: Beginning as early as May 9th and is anticipated to be complete within 6-weeks.
