

Sunrise Wind

Project Overview

The New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) has selected Sunrise Wind to negotiate an Offshore Wind Renewable Energy Credit (OREC) Agreement for an 880 MW offshore wind farm.

Sunrise Wind is bringing unparalleled experience in developing offshore wind to New York. Ørsted is the global leader in offshore wind, while Eversource is New England's largest energy company and premier electric transmission builder.

Benefits to New York

As part of our commitment to supporting Governor Cuomo's goal of establishing an enduring offshore wind supply chain in New York State, Sunrise Wind will support approximately 800 jobs through the project's development, construction and operation.

Sunrise Wind is bringing economic development to New York State and fostering the growth of the offshore wind industry for Long Island. Specific project benefits include:

- \$10 million for a National Workforce Training Center on Long Island, creating a curriculum and developing training programs that will support the next generation of jobs in the growing offshore wind industry
- Building a new Operation and Maintenance Hub in Port Jefferson, creating up to 100 new and permanent full-time jobs

50/50 partnership between Ørsted and Eversource, with support from Con Edison and the New York Power Authority

→ WHAT

880 MW offshore wind farm, with the potential capacity to power more than half a million homes

→ WHEN

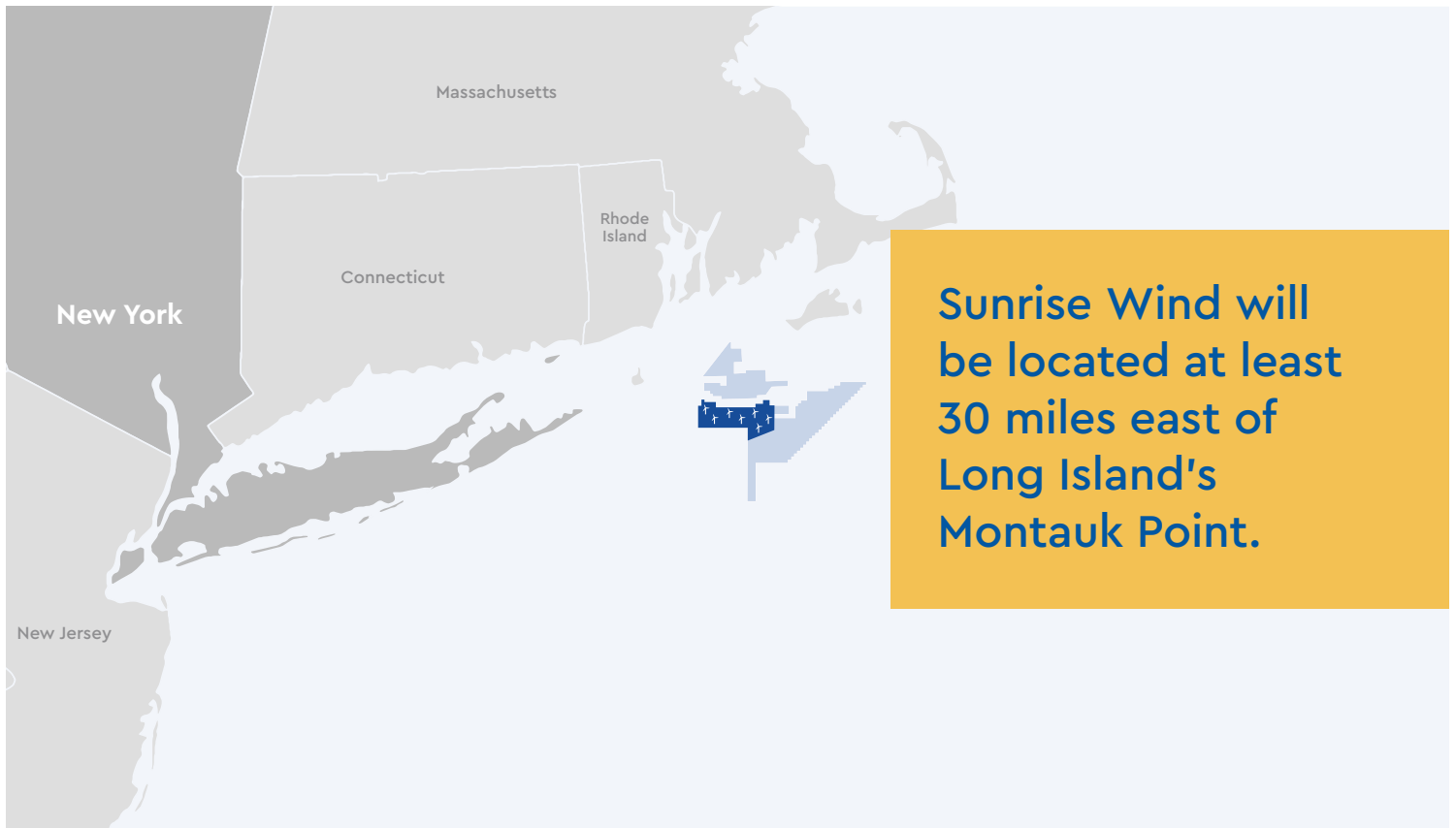
Expected to be fully operational by 2024

→ WHERE

At least 30 miles east of Montauk Point, virtually unnoticeable to Long Island residents and beachgoers; planned interconnection point is the Holbrook and West-Bus substation in the town of Brookhaven within the Long Island Power Authority's (LIPA) service territory

→ WHY

100% renewable energy to help realize New York's vision of becoming a leader in clean energy



- Investing \$11 million for major port infrastructure upgrades as part of the New York Ports Infrastructure Development Fund and Upstate New York Workforce Development Fund
- Fabrication key components for the foundations of offshore wind turbines at facilities in the Capitol Region

Sunrise Wind will also enter negotiations with New York State contractors and trade labor organizations on a Project Labor Agreement to cover construction activities for the Sunrise Wind project, and is committed to paying prevailing wages.

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
